#### iv. LERN Data Assistant:

Contractor/sub-grantee will continue to recruit ambulance providers in the state to collect and electronically submit National Emergency Medical Services Information System (NEMSIS)-compliant injury surveillance crash data to LERN on a regular basis in order to improve the completeness and accuracy of the injury surveillance/EMS system. Sub-grantee will also work with EMS providers and software vendors to facilitate timely import of all records into the EMS Registry and assist with transition to NEMSIS 3.5.
